REGULATIONS

The final text of these Supplementary Regulations shall be the English version which will be used should any dispute arise as to their interpretation. Headings in this document are for ease of reference only and do not form part of these Supplementary Regulations.

Article 1 – Organisation

The Competition shall be run in accordance with the 2024 Rally X sporting regulations, 2024 Swedish Automobile Association's national competition rules, the International Sporting Code and its appendices and these Supplementary regulations.

Event clarification:

As you might have seen in the articles from Rally X, Round 1 of Rally X will be driven as a Rally X Sprint format with staggering starts as in Rally, Sprint & Hillclimb

The format itself will be driven exactly like any other Rally X race in the past 10 years with 2 Free practice sessions, 3 Qualifying races, 2 or 3 semi finals depending on starters in each category and then of course the main final! The point scoring system will also work the same way as our traditional Rallycross races.

Fast explanation:

- Free practice groups will be drawn since it's the first race of the year. 2nd free practice work as time qualifying which will decide start order for Q1
- Q1, all cars in the category do the stage and fastest time secures 50 points, 2nd 45 and so on like the regulations say. Fastest in FP2 starts last.
- Q2, fastest cars in Q1 starts first. Same points system
- Q3, fastest cars in Q2 starts first. Same points system. Total points collected selects Semi finals drivers (Top 12 or 18) depending on starters. Championship points awarded like normal after qualifying.
- Semi finals, You race the 6 cars in your semi final lineup on time. Top 3 (or 2 depending on 2 or 3 semi finals) Move on to the final. "Pole position" starts last. Championship Points awarded like normal in Semi final.
- Final, The 6 drivers race for the overall win! "Pole position" starts last. Championship Points awarded like normal in final
