Emergency

Emergency

For emergencies you can always contact the organization during an event and/or competition days. If they are not present (anymore) and you need fire department, police or an ambulance, first call **112**. Then make sure that someone goes to the entrance as soon as possible so that you can accompany the emergency services or take any other measures.

AED

An AED (Automatic External Defibrillator) is available on the premises. This makes it possible for a person in cardiac arrest to bring the heart back to a normal rhythm. Rapid CPR together with the use of the AED significantly increases the chances of survival. **The AED is located in the canteen behind the bar.**

If you need first aid for an accident, speak to someone from the organization immediately (for example, in the cafeteria). You will be escorted to the medical station or medical assistance will be summoned.



Infrastructure

Public transportation

The nearest train station is located in **Eindhoven**. Unfortunately, there is no bus stop in the immediate vicinity of the track, which means you will have to walk for 15 minutes from the nearest bus stop to the track. For travel information, visit www.9292ov.nl

Internet

The track is located in a beautiful wooded area where mobile internet connections are not always optimal and landline internet access is limited. A limited WiFi facility is available for guests. The NRV is entitled to turn it off if the bandwidth needs to be reserved for other purposes.

First Aid

If you need first aid for an accident, speak to someone from the organization immediately (for example, in the cafeteria). You will be escorted to the medical station or medical assistance will be summoned.

Mandatory route to enter and exit circuit

It is not permitted to access the Eurocircuit via the dirt road on the Victoriedijk. This prohibition is actively enforced. You can reach the Eurocircuit via the Kempervennendreef.

Payment

You cannot withdraw cash on the premises of the track.
At the ticket office at the entrance and in the cafeteria, you can pay by debit card and cash.



Paddock rules

Placement of vehicles

Vehicles must be placed (and/or moved) in accordance with the instructions of the organization. Passenger cars, trailers and other vehicles that, in the opinion of the organization, do not need to be present in the paddock, will be parked directly at a designated place at the request of the organization.

Washing up and car wash

Cleaning a vehicle is permitted only in the car wash area next to the shower/toilet building. For washing dishes and cutlery, there is an outdoor sink next to the car wash area.

Rainwater drainage

There are street gullies in the paddock in several places. These are intended to drain excess rainwater. It is not allowed at all times to discharge other liquids such as oil, fuel, frying fat, etc. through these gullies.

Waste

The track is located in a natural environment and therefore we consider the care of a good environment very important. Please dispose of household waste produced on the grounds in the containers provided. Oil can be disposed of in the specially provided container near the TC.

Please separate waste as much as possible. Please put cans and bottles in the designated containers with a hole in the lid. Chemical and other waste must be disposed of by yourself and may not be left on the premises.



Paddock rules

Traffic rules

Dutch road traffic regulations apply to the entire site. Outside the competition lane, ride at walking pace (no faster than 5 km per hour). The use of mopeds, scooters, electric scooters and mopeds is not permitted. The organization may grant dispensation in appropriate situations.

Barbecue

Barbecuing is allowed until 10 p.m., provided it does not disturb your neighbours. Barbecuing directly on the ground is not permitted, nor is having an open fire (including a fire basket). Always have a fire extinguisher and/or bucket of water or sand next to the barbecue. Due to drought or other circumstances, a ban may still be imposed prior to or during the event.

Gas

Never place your gas cylinder inside a vehicle or residence and do not use hoses longer than 1 meter. Use only an approved (high pressure) propane gas hose and renew the hose at least every two years. Gas cylinders filled with LPG are not permitted.

Electricity

During events and/or race days, you may use electricity, paid or unpaid. Unless the NRV has granted an exemption, one connection of maximum 16A is available per team. Should a problem occur, please report it to the organization. In case of misuse or abuse of the connection, the NRV is entitled to stop the (further) use of the electricity connection.



Paddock rules

Lost and found objects

You can drop off items with our staff. Have you lost something? Please email secretariaat@nrv.club with a description of the lost item and possibly the location where you lost it.

Alcohol and drugs

Consumption of alcoholic beverages is permitted only in the cafeteria, on the terrace and in the very immediate vicinity of your pitch. Public drunkenness on and around the grounds is not permitted. Nor is possession and use of drugs and other stimulants.

Placement of vehicles

Vehicles must be placed (and/or moved) in accordance with the instructions of the organization. Passenger cars, trailers and other vehicles that, in the opinion of the organization, do not need to be present in the paddock, will be parked directly at a designated place at the request of the organization.

Liability

The NRV and other persons or organizations involved are not liable for theft, damage, accidents and other damages. Your stay is at your own risk. If you cause damage as a guest or participant, you will be liable for that damage. You are required to follow the instructions of the police, doctor, fire department and the instructions of or on behalf of the NRV. All persons present on the premises must know the contents of these rules.



Paddock rules

Pets

Pets are welcome, provided they are leashed at all times. No pets are allowed in the buildings. You may walk your animal outside the grounds. You must clean up excrement at all times (also outside of the premises).

Smoking

In accordance with Dutch law, smoking is not allowed in the buildings.

Toilet buildings

These are open at least during events and/or race days. Hot water and hot showers are free in most cases unless otherwise indicated. Water, especially hot water, is a scarce commodity and we ask that you use it sparingly. Please do not allow children to use the toilet blocks as a playground. Out of respect for fellow users, we ask everyone to leave the toilet blocks clean after use. Children under the age of 6 may only use the toilet blocks when accompanied by an adult. Toilet buckets or chemical toilets may only be emptied in the designated area.

Fire extinguisher

There must be at least 1 approved 6 kg fire extinguisher per competition vehicle that is actually ready to use. It must be located outside the trailer, bus or truck.



Paddock rules

Tarp (Grondzeil)

There must be a liquid-proof tarp under each competition vehicle of at least 3 x 6 meters.

Tranquility/behavior/motorized vehicles

Between 10 p.m. and 8 a.m., there must be silence on the grounds. The engines of competition vehicles may not be started between 8 p.m. and 8 a.m.

During events, vehicular traffic is prohibited on the grounds, with the exception of competition vehicles, of course. The entrance and exit are then closed to motorized traffic. You can always leave or enter the grounds on foot during events through the walking gate next to the main entrance.

If you experience noise or other inconvenience, please report it to the organization as soon as possible.

Normal social decency should be observed on the premises and any form of violence or other misconduct is prohibited.

Fire extinguisher

There must be at least 1 approved 6 kg fire extinguisher per competition vehicle that is actually ready to use. It must be located outside the trailer, bus or truck.



Track rules

The vehicle may only be driven by the driver in whose name the vehicle is registered for the training/competition.

The driver has a valid track permit (valid on training days only) or license (KNAF, foreign ASN or FIA).

The vehicle is safe and in good condition. Vehicles that in the opinion of the organization do not meet these standards may be denied (further) access to the track.

The driver of a vehicle must wear full safety equipment: racing overalls, fire-retardant underwear and socks, shoes, gloves, balaclava, helmet (with visor or goggles), HANS system, etc.

Taking passengers in competition vehicles is prohibited unless prior express written permission is given by the NRV board. Conditions may be attached to this permission. Any passengers must wear full safety equipment.

The vehicle must meet the noise regulations under the most recent KNAF Rallycross Regulations (in brief: idle measurement at 4,000 rpm maximum 85 dBA and drive-by maximum 96 dBA).

All drivers and passengers must sign and submit a "Waiver of liability" form to the organization prior to their first moment of entering the track.
