REGULATIONS

The final text of these Supplementary Regulations shall be the English version which will be used should any dispute arise as to their interpretation. Headings in this document are for ease of reference only and do not form part of these Supplementary Regulations.

Article 1 – Organisation

The Competition shall be run in accordance with the 2025 RallyX sporting regulations, 2025 Swedish Automobile Association's national competition rules, Latvian – Lithuanian Rallycross Championship regulations for the 2025 season, Baltic Rallycross Championship sporting regulations 2025, the International Sporting Code and its appendices and these Supplementary regulations.

Anyone who participates in the race do so under their own responsibility and at their own risk. FIA, Latvian Automobile Federation (LAF), RX Promotion AB and officials cannot without fault be liable for personal injury or property damage during the competition.

Article 4 – Insurances

In compliance with the legal prescriptions, the Organizer has contracted one or several insurance(s) guaranteeing the following risk(s):

Article 5 – Protests and Appeals

The protest fee is EUR 250 (plus deposit in case of technical protests).

The appeal fee set by the ASN is EUR 1,000.

All protests will be lodged in accordance with the FIA International Sporting Code and the 2025 Latvian Automobile Federation National Sporting code. All protests must be made in writing and handed to the Chairman of the Stewards, or in his absence one of the other Stewards of the Competition, or in their absence to the Race Director or Clerk of the Course (or their assistant) together with the required protest fee.
